

# 53<sup>rd</sup> St. Barnabas Scout Group

## Minutes of Parents Meeting held on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

1. Introductory welcome back, presenting the work done during the COVID-19 close down period since the 16<sup>th</sup> of March 2020 (online tasks, online camp fire, etc).  
Many thanks to the leaders for the on-going hard work, keeping the group active.
2. Based on the current regulations, the group will continue with the activities normally, following the hygienic guidelines using antiseptic gels, continuously cleaning by the Leaders and wearing masks for the indoor activities.
3. Work done during the COVID-19 closedown:
  - Yermasoyia's electrical box was installed.
  - Shelves were installed in Yermasoyia's Scout room.
  - Plugs were changed
  - Yermasoyia's outside area was cleaned.
  - A lot of games were made, to be used at the next camps and meetings.  
A big thank you to Andreas Moraris, for his voluntary offering on the implementation of the above.
  - Yermasoyia Municipality fixed the damaged road down to Yermasoyia Scout Hut.
4. The treasurer Maria Stylianou, made a short presentation for the year's main expenses and revenue. The analytical cash book will be prepared before 01/09/20.
5. Current financial position:
  - Cash in Bank: €5.258
  - Cash in Hand: €1.231
6. Recent donations received:
  - From Yoga online lessons
  - €350 from a parent, Sofia Stylianou
  - €500 from Moutayiaka Community Council.
7. Recent expenses:
  - €200 supplies for the hygienic regulations regarding COVID-19. Additional money will be spend for the same purpose.
  - €450 for the Scout Shop.
8. Upcoming expenses for Yermasoyia Scout Hut:
  - Installation of electrical wiring.
  - Small stones for the upper level.
  - Levelling the ground where the small stones will be placed.
  - Building trench and place a 6m grate at the highest level of the hut, to prevent the rain water coming down on the road. Water will be diverted to the upper level, to avoid the destruction of the recently repaired road.

9. Extra upcoming expenses:
  - 1 kayak to be purchased for around €400 - €450 and hopefully one more to be purchased next year.  
We already have 6 kayaks, some of them to be repaired.
  - 4 life jackets minimum to be purchased, for around €30 - €35 each.
  - Upgrading the software of lap top.
  - Purchase a new colour printer.
  - Purchase equipment and other material, to provide better quality for the summer camp.
10. Members of the Parents Committee, to visit again Yermasoyia's mayor for the installation of water at the Scout Hut.
11. Apply for online access for the account of 53<sup>rd</sup> at Hellenic Bank.
12. In September 2020, 4 cubs are going up to Scouts as leaping wolves and the Republic Award will be awarded to 1 Explorer.
13. Upcoming activities:  
(All activities will take place to organised places where the health protocol applies)
  - 18/07/20 Trip to Waterpark for all members.
  - Platania Scout Campsite for all members, 4 days and 3 nights.  
Dates will be announced soon.  
There are cleaners at the campsite, cleaning and sanitising the place.
14. Trip to Switzerland Jamboree 2021:
  - 42 places which are already full
  - Next payment of €4.300 will be on 30/09/20.
  - Final payment will be made in February 2021.
  - Cancellation policy on behalf of Kisc:  
3 months before > full refund.  
2 months before > 75% refund.
  - Flights will be booked in February 2021 and any cancelation will be subjected to the terms of that airline.
15. Summer 2020 trips cancelled:
  - Essex International Jamboree 2020:  
53<sup>rd</sup> paid €3.645 for flights  
53<sup>rd</sup> paid €807 for the campsite - €743 was refunded.  
Parents paid in total €3.100. Each parent paid €350 – refund on this amount depends on Ryan Airs Refund (still waiting). The Group has asked for Cash refund.
  - UK Three Peak Challenge:  
53<sup>rd</sup> lost €92  
Leaders and the organising team lost money paid for themselves.
  - Poland European Jamboree 2020:  
53<sup>rd</sup> lost €375.  
Each parent paid €500 - €375 refunded.
