Award of Completion Requirements	
<p>A. Participation: Be actively involved in your Explorer Groups activities for at least 12 months from your admission. During this time and for the continuous time of 4 weeks perform your duties in the Patrol and Group.</p>	
<p>B. Religion/Country: Take an active part in the procedures of your religion and understand to meaning of your Faith.</p> <p>Have a general knowledge of the history of your Country and one historical fact or person of your choice Do research and prepare a presentation for the Explorer Group.</p>	
<p>C. Values: Take part in a work group in an activity that relates directly to one of the following: Freedom, Respect for my fellow people, Tolerance and Understanding for difference, Human Rights, Children’s Rights, Equality, Justice and Democracy.</p> <p>Any other activity suggested by said explorer and approved by the Explorer Council</p>	
<p>D. International Relations: Actively take part in the planning and preparing, as well as direct participation, in the JOTI and JOTA.</p> <p>Contact scouts from at least three (3) different countries, with whom you must keep in contact for at least 3 months.</p>	
<p>E. Leadership: Serve as an assistant in one of the other 2 sections of the Scout Group (Cubs, Scouts) for a period of at least 2 months, take on leadership role in the organizing of at least one major activity of the section, under the supervision and guidance of the section leader.</p>	
<p>F. Environment: As part of a work group with organize an activity that relates to one of the following: Natural environment, Human environment, Environment and Energy, City and Environment, The role of water in the environment, Protection of the Seas, Protection of an endangered species (animal, serpent, bird, plant etc), Ecosystem</p> <p>Any other activity suggested by the work group and approved by the Explorer Council.</p>	
<p>G. Specialty As a member of a work group , participate in an action related to: Flora and Fauna of my country, Geology /Geophysics, Agronomy/Gardening.</p> <p>Any other activity suggested by the work group and approved by the Explorer Council</p>	
<p>H. Scouting technique and Prospective exploration:</p> <p>Organize and take part in activities in the countryside for a total of 3 days and 3 nights.</p> <p>During one of these take part in a hike of at least 8 km using a map. Chart a selected part of this hike using ταχυ οδοιπορικο .During the hike use a GPS and save the route of the hike. Chart the area where you are going to be staying. During the hike a keep a diary which will later be presented and make a collection of your choice (trees-plants-photographs, rocks, leaves etc).</p> <p>During the activities at least half of your meals are cooked on open fire without the use of cooking utensils. In at least one of these activities include in the program, in the form of emergency drills, elements of scouting technique from one of the following sections: First Aid, Firefighting, Lifesaving, Topography, Pioneering, Building a Bivy.</p>
